
HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 4.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the House of Representatives of the Alaska Territorial Legislature, the Senate concurring; that the Speaker of the House and the President of the Senate appoint a committee of two members each to confer with the Governor of the Territory of Alaska relative to securing O. B. privileges in the use of the Government cable and telegraph lines in Alaska by the members of the Territorial Legislature while in session.

Adopted by the House, March 10, 1923.

Concurred in by the Senate, March 12, 1923.

HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 5.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the House of Representatives, the Senate concurring, that a committee of two members from each House of the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska be appointed to invite Honorable Dan Sutherland, Delegate from Alaska, to address the Senate and House of Representatives in joint session assembled, at such time as shall be arranged by said committee and the Delegate.

Adopted by the House, March 16, 1923.

Passed by the Senate, March 19, 1923.

HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 7.

BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives, the Senate concurring, that the report of the Banking Board of the Territory of Alaska be printed;

That under the joint direction of the Finance Committee of the Senate and the Printing and Purchasing Committee of the House bids be called for the printing of five hundred (500) copies of the report of the Banking Board of the Territory of Alaska, and that the award of contract for such printing be to the lowest bidder.
