SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 1.

BE IT RESOLVED That the Senate of the Sixth Alaska Legislature extend a vote of thanks to the Secretary, the Treasurer, the Attorney General and the Commissioner of Education of the Territory of Alaska for their valuable assistance in compiling reports pertaining to their respective offices and submitting the same to the Legislature.

SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 2.
