

CHAPTER 8.

AN ACT

[S. B. 28]

To amend Section 1814, Compiled Laws of Alaska relative to liens of judgments of a justice court.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That Section 1814 of the Compiled Laws of Alaska is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

Effect of docketing judgment in District Court, lien on real property.

“From the time of docketing a judgment of a justice court, as provided in the last section, the same shall be a lien upon the real property of the defendant, as if it were a judgment of the district court wherein it is docketed.”

Approved March 27, 1923.

CHAPTER 9.

AN ACT

[S. B. 20]

To amend Section 916, Compiled Laws of Alaska, by permitting causes of action at law to be united where the same arise from the same transaction.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That Section 916 of the Compiled Laws of Alaska is hereby amended to read as follows:

What causes of action may be united in same complaint. “The plaintiff may unite several causes of action in the same complaint when they all arise out of—

“First. Contract, express or implied; or

“Second. Injuries, with or without force, to the person; or

“Third. Injuries, with or without force, to property; or
