CHAPTER 1.

AN ACT

[H. B. 5]

Making appropriation for the payment of a deficiency in the appropriation for bounty on wolves; bounty on eagles; office rent for the Attorney General, Commissioner of Education and the Territorial Treasurer, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the General Fund of the Territorial Treasury, the sum of Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500.00), for payment of bounty on wolves for the period ending March 31, 1925; the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00), for payment of bounty on eagles for the period ending March 31, 1925; the sum of Forty Two Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$42.50), for rent of office for Attorney General for the period ending March 31, 1925; the sum of Thirty One Dollars and Twenty-Five Cents (\$31.25), for rent of office for the Commissioner of Education for the period ending March 31, 1925; the sum of Thirty Three Dollars and Seventy-Five Cents (\$33.75), for rent of office for Territorial Treasurer for the period ending March 31, 1925, or so much of the several amounts thereof as may be necessary for the payment of accounts justly due from the Territory under existing Acts.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
