Provided, that such continuance or postponement may also be made by the Commissioner, of his own motion, whenever it appears necessary so to do in order to ascertain and determine the true mental condition of such person.

## CHAPTER 13.

### AN ACT

[H. B. 47]

To amend Chapter 35 of the Laws of 1919 relative to duties of Commissioner of Health, and declaring an emergency.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. That Section three (3) of Chapter thirty-five (35) of the Laws of 1919 be amended by adding thereto the following sub-section, to be designated as sub-section 9:

“9. He shall secure and distribute anti-toxins, vaccines and serums.”

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
