

CHAPTER 24.

AN ACT

[S. B. 29]

To provide for the payment to Forest J. Hunt for salary for the month of March, 1925, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. The sum of Four Hundred and Fifty Dollars is hereby appropriated for the payment of the salary of Forest J. Hunt as Territorial Senator for the month of March, 1925.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall be in full force and effect on and after its passage and approval.

CHAPTER 25.

AN ACT

[H. B. 4]

To amend Sections 1605 and 1606 of the Compiled Laws of the Territory of Alaska, 1913, to permit the appointment of corporations or national banking associations, authorized by law, as executors or administrators of estates of deceased persons.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That Section 1605, of the Compiled Laws of the Territory of Alaska, 1913, be, and the same is, hereby amended to read as follows :

“Section 1605. When a will is proven, letters testamentary shall be issued to the person, persons, corporation, or national banking association, therein named as executor or executors, or to such of them as give notice of their acceptance of the trust and are qualified. If all the persons, corporations, or national

banking associations therein named decline to accept or be disqualified, letters of administration, with the will annexed, shall be issued to the person to whom the administration would have been granted if there had been no will."

Section 2. That Section 1606, of the Compiled Laws of the Territory of Alaska, 1913, be, and the same is, hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 1606. Administration of the estate of an intestate shall be granted by the Commissioner authorized to take proof of a will, as prescribed in Section 1604, in case such intestate has made a will. Administration shall be granted, and letters thereof issued, as follows: (1) to the widow or next of kin, or both, in the discretion of the court; (2) to one or more of the principal creditors; or (3) to any other person, corporation, or national banking association competent and qualified whom the Court may select."

CHAPTER 26.

AN ACT

[H. B. 13]

To appropriate the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00), to aid shipping in the Territory of Alaska, along the coast of Cook's Inlet, from Anchorage to Iliamna Bay, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That the Governor of the Territory of Alaska is authorized to pay a sum of money, not to exceed Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00), and not to exceed Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) during any
