

CHAPTER 37.

AN ACT

[H. B. 81]

To provide for the printing of the Report of the Mine Inspector for Alaska upon industrial accidents, compensation and insurance for the biennium 1923-1924, making an appropriation therefor, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That the Territorial Mine Inspector, ex-officio Labor Commissioner for Alaska be, and he is hereby, authorized to have printed as many copies of his Report upon Industrial Accidents, Compensation and Insurance in Alaska for the biennium ending December 31, 1924, as called for by Chapter 96, Session Laws of 1923, as may in his judgment be necessary.

Territorial Mine Inspector authorized to print report for biennium ending Dec. 31, 1924.

Section 2. That the sum of Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars be, and the same is hereby, appropriated out of the General Fund of the Territory, not otherwise appropriated, to carry out the provisions of this Act.

Section 3. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval.

CHAPTER 38.

AN ACT

[H. B. 82.]

To assist the City of Haines in paying off the indebtedness against the schoolhouse in said town, and making an appropriation therefor."

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. The sum of Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary, is

hereby appropriated for the purpose of assisting the City of Haines in paying off the indebtedness caused by the construction of a schoolhouse.

Section 2. The sum appropriated in Section 1 of this Act shall be expended under the direction of the Commissioner of Education, and shall be paid by the Treasurer of the Territory upon warrants drawn upon the Treasurer by the Commissioner of Education, specifying the purpose for which such warrants are drawn. Such warrants shall be payable to the Treasurer of the School Board of the City of Haines.

Section 3. The monies appropriated by Section 1 of this Act shall become available for the purposes herein stated whenever the City Council of the City of Haines shall have appropriated for the purpose of paying off the indebtedness against the schoolhouse in said City, a sum equal to the amount hereby appropriated and an additional amount sufficient to pay off the remainder of the indebtedness; it being the intention of this Act that the Territory shall pay off one-half of the indebtedness not to exceed the sum of Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00) upon condition that the City of Haines shall pay the entire remainder.

CHAPTER 39.

AN ACT

[H. B. 80.]

To amend Chapter 62 of the Session Laws of 1917, entitled "An Act for the Establishment of the Alaska Agricultural College and School of Mines in accordance with the provisions of the Act of Congress approved March 4th, 1915, and to grant a Charter to the Alaska Agricultural College and School of Mines," as amended by Chapter 88 of the Alaska Session Laws of 1923.
