

Misdemeanor to refuse payment of money due for labor upon demand.

from execution so to do, shall wilfully or fraudulently, with intent to annoy, harass, oppress, or defraud an employee, refuse to pay such employee upon demand the money due him for labor as provided in this Act, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction thereof, shall be fined in any sum not exceeding one thousand (\$1,000.00) dollars.

Section 4. Chapter 49 of the Session Laws of Alaska, 1923, is hereby repealed.

CHAPTER 46.

AN ACT

[H. B. 67]

Authorizing the Territorial Board of Road Commissioners for Alaska to expend in locating, clearing, grading and preparing airplane landing fields at places to be selected by it in the Fourth Division of the Territory of Alaska a sum not to exceed \$20,000 out of the monies appropriated for construction and maintenance of roads, trails, bridges and ferries and which may be allotted to the said Fourth Division of the Territory of Alaska.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Authorization for expenditure funds for airplane landing fields in Fourth Division.

Section 1. That the Territorial Board of Road Commissioners for Alaska is hereby authorized to expend out of the monies appropriated at this session of the Territorial Legislature, for the construction and maintenance of roads, trails, bridges and ferries, and which may be allotted to the Fourth Division of the Territory of Alaska, the sum of Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00), or so much thereof as may in the judgment of the Board be necessary or advisable, in the location, clearing, grading and preparing of airplane landing fields in the said Fourth Division of the Territory of Alaska, at such places as the Board may select.

Section 2. That the monies so expended by the Territorial Board of Road Commissioners under this Act shall be expended upon landing fields, not within or adjacent to incorporated towns and shall be expended only in cooperation with the people of the several communities where such fields may be located upon such terms of cooperation as the Commission shall determine.

May be expended by Territorial Board Road Commissioners in cooperation with communities.

CHAPTER 47.

AN ACT

[H. B. 69]

To amend Chapter 42 of Title XV of the Compiled Laws of Alaska, relating to the trial of criminal actions in Justices' Courts, by amending Section 2527 of said Chapter.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That Section 2527, Chapter 42 of Title XV of the Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1913, relating to the trial of criminal cases in Justices' Courts, be, and the same is hereby, amended to read as follows:

C. L. A.
Amended.

“Section 2527. That upon a plea other than a plea of guilty, if the defendant expressly waive a trial by jury, the justice must proceed to try the issue.”
