

“Section 10. The Territorial Treasurer is hereby authorized to appoint the United States Commissioners of the several precincts of the Territory or any other persons as his agents to take applications, issue the licenses and collect the license fees herein provided for. The said Commissioners or other agents of the Treasurer shall receive for their services Fifty (50) Cents for each resident fishermen’s license so issued and a fee of One Dollar and Fifty Cents (\$1.50) for each nonresident fishermen’s license so issued. The Commissioners or other agents of the Treasurer shall monthly transmit to the Treasurer all fees so collected by them together with a full account of the same.

Fee for issuing license.

Monthly accounting by agents.

The Treasurer shall not be liable for the defalcation or failure to account for the fees so collected by any Commissioner or other agent so appointed.”

Treasurer not liable for agents’ collections.

Section 3. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall take effect upon its passage and approval by the Governor.

CHAPTER 58.

AN ACT

[S. B. 28]

Fixing the place of trials for prosecutions for crimes or offenses in the Territory of Alaska and repealing all Acts or parts of Acts in conflict therewith.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That all prosecutions for crimes or offenses within the District of Alaska shall be had within

Prosecutions for crime to be in Division where same committed.

the Division of said District where the same were committed, unless the Court or the Judge thereof, upon the application of the defendant, shall order the cause to be transferred for prosecution to another Division of said District.

Cause may be transferred when.

Section 2. All Acts or parts of Acts in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

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## CHAPTER 59.

### AN ACT

[S. B. 171]

To amend Section 41 of Chapter 98 of the Session Laws of Alaska, 1923, by providing for attorney's fees.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

That Section 41 of Chapter 98 of the Session Laws of Alaska for 1923, the said Chapter being entitled: "An Act relating to the measure and recovery of compensation of injured employees in all business, occupations, work, employments, and industries employing five or more employees in the Territory of Alaska, except domestic service, agriculture, dairying and the operation of railroads as common carriers, and relating to the Compensation to designated beneficiaries where such injuries result in death, defining and regulating the liability of employers to their employees in connection with such business and industries and repealing all Acts and parts of Acts in conflict with this Act;" be and it is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 41. If the Court, before whom any proceedings are brought under this Act, determines that
