CHAPTER 68.

AN ACT

[H. B. 87]

To provide for the maintenance of telephone lines on Seward Peninsula; making an appropriation therefor, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. The sum of Four Thousand (\$4,000.00) Dollars is hereby appropriated, or so much thereof as may be required, to be expended by the Territorial Board of Road Commissioners, in cooperation with the Alaska Road Commission, for the purpose of maintaining permanent telephone lines and connections between Nome and Kougarok, and between Nome, Solomon, Council and Candle, including the subsidiary lines connecting at these centers on Seward Peninsula, during the twenty-four (24) months beginning July 1, 1925, and ending June 30, 1927; provided that such expenditure for maintenance be made only upon condition that rates be fixed for telephone communication over said lines during said period which in the judgment of the Governor are fair and reasonable and consistent with rates of similar lines in Alaska.

Section 2. Payment under this Act shall be made quarterly by the Territorial Treasurer upon vouchers approved by the Alaska Road Commission. Payments how made.

Section 3. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall be effective immediately upon its passage and approval. Emergency.

CHAPTER 69.

AN ACT

[Com. Substitute for H. B. 71]

Authorizing the Territorial Board of Road Commissioners for Alaska to expend in the construction of a trail from the Nizina Bridge, in the Third Judicial Division of Alaska, to the town of Chisana, also known as Shushanna, the sum of Six Thousand (\$6,000.00) Dollars, out of the moneys appropriated at this session of the Legislature for the construction and maintenance of roads, trails, bridges and ferries, which may be allotted to the said Third Judicial Division of Alaska; providing for cooperation between said Board and the Board of Road Commissioners for Alaska in the construction of said trail; providing for the payment of the said sum under a cooperative agreement; and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That the Territorial Board of Road Commissioners for Alaska is hereby authorized to expend, out of the moneys appropriated at this session of the Territorial Legislature for the construction and maintenance of roads, trails, bridges and ferries, and which may be allotted to the Third Judicial Division of the Territory of Alaska, the sum of Six Thousand (\$6,000.00) Dollars, for the construction of a trail from the Nizina Bridge in the Nizina Mining District, McCarthy Recording Precinct, in the Third Judicial Divi- Appropriation for construction of trail from Nizina Bridge to town of Chisana.
