

## CHAPTER 8.

## AN ACT

[H. B. 7]

To amend Section 6 of Chapter 13 of the Laws of 1915 by extending time for filing miners lien.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

That Section 6 of Chapter 13 of the Laws of 1915 is hereby amended to read as follows:

“Section 6. Every person claiming the benefit of this Act shall within sixty days after the rendition of the services or the cessation of the work or labor mentioned in Section One, file for record in the recorder’s office of the precinct in which the mine or mining claim, or other property on which the lien is claimed was situated or used, his claim of lien, which claim of lien shall contain a true statement of his demand and the amount thereof, after deducting all just credits and offsets, with the name of the person by whom he was employed and a statement of the terms and conditions of his contract of employment, together with a description of the property on which the lien is claimed sufficient for identification and the name of the owner or reputed owner thereof. The lien claim shall be verified by the oath of the lien claimant or some one in his behalf having personal knowledge of the facts, and in case there is no express contract of employment the claim shall state what the work, labor and services are reasonably worth. Should the employment be continuous or there be one contract of employment, the lien claimant may in one lien notice claim his lien against more than one of the different classes of property mentioned in Sec-

tion One of this Act, provided the amount claimed against each separate class of property be specified, the property sought to be charged be identified sufficiently, and the name of the owner or reputed owner thereof be stated."

## CHAPTER 9.

### AN ACT

[H. B. 19]

To appropriate funds for the erection and construction of a school house at Kenai, Alaska, making provision for the construction of such school house, and declaring an emergency.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. The sum of Seven Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$7,500.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska not otherwise appropriated, for the erection and construction of a public school house at and in the village of Kenai, Alaska. The sum hereby appropriated is in addition to the sum now permitted by existing law to be expended by the Commissioner of Education of the Territory of Alaska, with the approval of the Governor as Chairman of the Territorial Board of Education, for the construction and equipment of school houses in districts outside of incorporated towns, as provided in Chapter 60 of the Session Laws of Alaska of the year 1923.
