

Senate Resolution

SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 1.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Seventh Legislature of the Territory of Alaska that:

WHEREAS Senator Forest J. Hunt was duly and regularly elected a member of this body from the First Division of the Territory of Alaska at the election therefor held on November 4, 1924; and

WHEREAS Senator Hunt is now absent in the city of Seattle on account of illness, and is not able to be present at this time to take part in the deliberations of the Senate; and

WHEREAS Senator Hunt has duly taken and subscribed to his oath of office in the said State of Washington before a Notary Public of that State duly commissioned and qualified, which oath of office is in words and figures as follows, to-wit:

"OATH OF FORREST J. HUNT AS SENATOR
FROM
FIRST DIVISION TERRITORY OF ALASKA

FORREST J. HUNT, of lawful age being duly sworn upon oath states, I do solemnly swear that I will defend and support the Constitution of the United States and the laws of the United States and Territory of Alaska, and perform all the duties of Senator from the First Division, on which I am about to enter, and therein do equal right and justice to all men, so help me God.

WHEREAS the matter of said oath and the validity thereof has been referred to the Honorable John Rustgard, Attorney General for Alaska, who has rendered to this body an opinion, stating that he can find no legal objection to said oath or the form thereof; and

WHEREAS Senator Hunt will probably be sufficiently recovered in health to be able to be present and take part in the deliberations of the Senate within three (3) weeks from the date hereof; be it therefore

RESOLVED that Senator Forest J. Hunt of the First Division is a member of the Senate of the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska duly elected and qualified and entitled to all of the rights, powers and emoluments of such office; and be it further

RESOLVED that by reason of the illness and unavoidable absence of Senator Hunt, he be and hereby is granted leave of absence for the period of three (3) weeks from the date hereof; and be it further

RESOLVED that this resolution be spread upon the journal of the Senate, and that copies thereof duly certified by the Secretary of the Senate be furnished to the Governor of Alaska, the Secretary of the Territory of Alaska, and Senator Hunt.
