CHAPTER 1.

AN ACT.

[H. B. 2]

Making appropriation for the payment of a deficiency in the appropriation for bounty on wolves; and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the General Fund of the Territorial Treasury, the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00), for payment of bounty on wolves for the period ending March 31, 1927, or so much thereof as may be necessary for the payment of accounts justly due from the Territory under existing laws. Deficiency, bounty on wolves.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.

Approved March 25, 1927.

CHAPTER 2.

AN ACT

[H. B. 5]

To appropriate funds for the erection and construction of a school house at Kotzebue, Alaska, making provision for the construction of such school house, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. The sum of Three Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$3,500.00), or so much thereof as may be neces- Appropriation.
