

to the provisions of and for the relief of the persons described in Chapter 46 of the Session Laws of Alaska of the year 1923, the same being an Act entitled: "An Act to provide allowances for certain aged residents of Alaska, and for other purposes, and repealing all acts or parts of acts in conflict herewith," approved April 21, 1923.

Section 2. The sum hereby appropriated shall be immediately available and shall remain so available until entirely expended.

Section 3. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall be of full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval.

## CHAPTER 13.

### AN ACT

[S. B. 26]

To amend the various statues [statutes] of Alaska by substituting the word "Territory" in place of "District" wherever the latter is used to designate the Territory of Alaska.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Whenever in any statute over which the Legislature of the Territory has jurisdiction, the word "District" is employed to designate the Territory of Alaska the word "Territory" shall be substituted for the word "District" in the Revision of the Statutes of Alaska provided for and to be hereafter made.
