

## CHAPTER 14.

## AN ACT

[H. B. 45]

To provide for erection of monument to commemorate transfer of Alaska to United States, and to appropriate Seven Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$750.00) therefor.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Monument commemorating transfer of Alaska from Russia to be erected.

Section 1. That for the purpose of commemorating the transfer of Alaska from Russia to United States an appropriate monument with bronze tablet shall be erected at the place at Sitka, Alaska, where the formal ceremonies of that transfer took place on the 18th day of October, 1867; That the Governor be authorized to arrange with the Department of Alaska, American Legion for the securement and erection of such monument and Tablet.

Appropriation.

Section 2. That the sum of Seven Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$750.00), or so much thereof as shall be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the treasury of the Territory of moneys not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of paying the cost of such monument and tablet and the expenses connected with the erection thereof. Said sum shall be paid by the Treasurer upon vouchers approved by the Governor and Department Adjutant of the American Legion.
