

CHAPTER 15.

AN ACT

[S. B. 34]

To appropriate the sum of \$693.36 to pay the balance of salary due Miss Mary Monagle for teaching in the Woodrow School District, Third Judicial Division of the Territory of Alaska, during the year 1925-26, with interest for one year at 8 per cent per annum, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That the sum of \$693.36 is hereby appropriated out of the funds of the Territory of Alaska not otherwise appropriated, to pay Miss Mary Monagle the balance of the salary due her from the Woodrow School District in the Third Judicial Division of the Territory of Alaska for teaching during the school year 1925-26, with interest for one year at the rate of 8 per cent per annum, the amount hereby appropriated being for the balance due with said interest.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.

CHAPTER 16.

AN ACT

[S. B. 9]

Authorizing the Territorial Board of Road Commissioners for Alaska to construct an automobile and wagon road which will connect the towns of Anchorage and Matanuska in the Third Judicial Division of the Territory of Alaska, to cost not exceeding Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00), of which amount the sum of Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) is made available out of monies appropriated at this session of the Legislature for the construction and maintenance of roads, trails, bridges and ferries and which may be allotted to the said Third

Judicial Division; providing for cooperation between said Board and the Board of Road Commissioners in the construction of said road, and for the expenditure of said money under a cooperative agreement, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Construction wagon road to connect Anchorage and Matanuska authorized.

Section 1. That the Territorial Board of Road Commissioners for the Territory of Alaska is hereby authorized to construct an automobile and wagon road which will connect the towns of Anchorage and Matanuska in the Third Judicial Division of the Territory of Alaska by the most direct and economical route; that in the performance of said work and the construction of said road the said Board shall not expend more than the sum of Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00) and shall not obligate the Territory in excess of the amounts which the Legislature may from time to time appropriate for such purpose; that there is hereby appropriated the sum of Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) to be used for carrying out the provisions of this act, which amount shall be made available out of the monies which may be appropriated at the present session of the Legislature and allotted to the Third Judicial Division of Alaska for the construction and maintenance of roads, trails, bridges and ferries, and which shall continue available until expended.

Territorial engineer to survey and determine route.

Section 2. That so soon as possible after the passage and approval of this act the Territorial Engineer shall survey and determine the most feasible route for the construction of said road; that in the construction of said road, the Territorial Board of Road Commissioners shall have the authority to enter into a cooperative agreement with the Board of Road Commissioners for Alaska, and in case such cooperative agreement is entered into the monies appropriated by the Territory and employed in the construction of said road may be

expended under the direction of said Board of Road Commissioners for Alaska.

Section 3. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall be in full force and effect on and after its passage and approval.

CHAPTER 17.

AN ACT

[S. B. 7]

To appropriate funds for the erection and construction of a school house at Tanana, Alaska, making provision for the construction of such school house, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. The sum of Three Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$3,500.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska not otherwise appropriated, for the erection and construction of a public school house at and in the city of Tanana, Alaska. This sum shall not be in addition to any money otherwise appropriated by the Territory for the construction of school buildings.

Section 2. The sum by this act appropriated shall be expended under the direction of the Commissioner of Education, and shall be paid by the Treasurer of the Territory of Alaska upon warrants drawn upon the Treasurer by said Commissioner of Education, specifying the purpose for which such warrants are drawn. Such warrants shall be payable to the Treasurer of the School Board of the City of Tanana, Alaska.

Section 3. The Commissioner of Education is hereby authorized to cause such school house to be constructed,
