## CHAPTER 17.

### AN ACT

[S. B. 7]

To appropriate funds for the erection and construction of a school house at Tanana, Alaska, making provision for the construction of such school house, and declaring an emergency.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. The sum of Three Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$3,500.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska not otherwise appropriated, for the erection and construction of a public school house at and in the city of Tanana, Alaska. This sum shall not be in addition to any money otherwise appropriated by the Territory for the construction of school buildings.

Section 2. The sum by this act appropriated shall be expended under the direction of the Commissioner of Education, and shall be paid by the Treasurer of the Territory of Alaska upon warrants drawn upon the Treasurer by said Commissioner of Education, specifying the purpose for which such warrants are drawn. Such warrants shall be payable to the Treasurer of the School Board of the City of Tanana, Alaska.

Section 3. The Commissioner of Education is hereby authorized to cause such school house to be constructed,

to cause plans for such school building to be drawn, and designate the location thereof and the character of construction and equipment; and said construction shall be under the control and supervision of said Commissioner of Education.

Section 4. No part of the sum hereby appropriated, or of any other Territorial moneys, may be used for purchase, rental or acquisition of the grounds on which such school house is built, and such ground must be furnished to the Territory without cost to the Territory.

Entrants

Section 5. The school building so to be erected shall at all times be available for the education of children who reside within or outside the present corporate limits of the City of Tanana, Alaska, and no tuition shall be paid by pupils residing outside the present corporate limits of the City of Tanana who desire to attend said school.

Section 6. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.

## CHAPTER 18.

### AN ACT

[S. B. 8]

To create the office of Commissioner of Transportation for Prospectors and prescribe its duties and appropriate funds for its purpose.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. The office of Commissioner of Transportation for Prospectors is hereby created. The functions of that office shall be as hereinafter prescribed, and the Territorial Mine Inspector shall be the ex-officio Commissioner of Transportation for Prospectors.
