

Laws of Alaska

CHAPTER 1.

AN ACT.

[H. B. 2]

Making appropriation for the payment of a deficiency in the appropriation for bounty on wolves; and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the General Fund of the Territorial Treasury, the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00), for payment of bounty on wolves for the period ending March 31, 1927, or so much thereof as may be necessary for the payment of accounts justly due from the Territory under existing laws.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.

CHAPTER 2.

AN ACT

[H. B. 5]

To appropriate funds for the erection and construction of a school house at Kotzebue, Alaska, making provision for the construction of such school house, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. The sum of Three Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$3,500.00), or so much thereof as may be neces-

sary, is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska not otherwise appropriated, for the erection and construction of a public school house at and in the village of Kotzebue, Alaska, provided however the sum herein specified shall not be in addition to any other sums otherwise authorized by law.

To be expended under direction Commissioner of Education.

Section 2. The sum by this act appropriated shall be expended under the direction of the Commissioner of Education, and shall be paid by the Treasurer of the Territory of Alaska upon warrants drawn upon the Treasurer by said Commissioner of Education, specifying the purpose for which such warrants are drawn.

Commissioner Education to make all arrangements for location and construction.

Section 3. The Commissioner of Education is hereby authorized to cause plans for such school building to be prepared, to designate the location of such building, provide for the purchase and transportation of the material for such construction and to make such contract for the erection of the building as he finds proper.

No part of appropriation to be used acquisition of grounds.

Section 4. No part of the sum hereby appropriated, or of any other Territorial moneys, may be used for purchase, rental or acquisition of the grounds on which such school house is built, and such ground must be furnished to the Territory without cost to the Territory.

Section 5. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.
