

## CHAPTER 20.

## AN ACT

[H. B. 20]

To repeal Chapter 89 of the Laws of 1923 entitled "An Act to impose a license tax on the business of fur-farming and trading in pelts and skins of fur bearing animals, and repealing Chapter 42 of the Laws of 1921."

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. That Chapter 89 of the Laws of Alaska for the year 1923 is hereby repealed, provided, however, that this repeal shall not operate to release any obligation or liability incurred under said Act but the same shall be deemed in full force for the purpose of enforcing such liabilities and obligations.

## CHAPTER 21.

## AN ACT

[H. B. 33]

To appropriate funds for the erection and construction of a school house at Yakutat, Alaska, making provision for the construction of such school house, and declaring an emergency.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. The sum of Seven Thousand Dollars (\$7,000.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska not otherwise appropriated, for the erection and construction of a public school house at and in the village of Yakutat, Alaska, Provided however the sum herein specified shall not be in addition to any other sums otherwise authorized by law.

How expended.

Section 2. The sum by this Act appropriated shall be expended under the direction of the Commissioner of Education, and shall be paid by the Treasurer of the Territory of Alaska upon warrants drawn upon the Treasurer by said Commissioner of Education, specifying the purpose for which such warrants are drawn.

Commissioner to arrange for construction.

Section 3. The Commissioner of Education is hereby authorized to cause plans for such school building to be prepared, to designate the location of such building, provide for the purchase and transportation of the material for such construction and to make such contract for the erection of the building as he finds proper.

Grounds to be furnished without cost to Territory.

Section 4. No part of the sum hereby appropriated, or of any other Territorial moneys, may be used for the purchase, rental or acquisition of the grounds on which such school house is built, and such ground must be furnished to the Territory without cost to the Territory.

Section 5. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall take effect immediately on its passage and approval.

## CHAPTER 22.

### AN ACT

[H. B. 42]

To reimburse Sitka Lodge No. 1350 of the Loyal Order of Moose, for labor and supplies expended on the Pioneers' Home Cemetery Road, making an appropriation therefor, and declaring an emergency.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. The sum of Four Hundred Dollars (\$400) is hereby appropriated to reimburse the Sitka
