

## CHAPTER 26.

## AN ACT

[S. B. 39]

To appropriate Four Thousand Three Hundred and Forty Dollars (\$4,340.00) to pay deficit in appropriation for tuition fees to Municipalities for education of non-resident children.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

That the sum of Four Thousand Three Hundred and Forty Dollars (\$4,340.00) is hereby appropriated to supply the deficit in appropriations "for the payment of tuition to incorporated towns for pupils residing outside the limits of such incorporated towns and attending either elementary or high school therein," for the two biennial periods ending June 30th, 1925, and June 30th, 1927, respectively, and the same may be disbursed as under and in conformity with the original appropriation for that purpose.

## CHAPTER 27.

## AN ACT

[S. B. 45]

To appropriate the sum of Fifteen Hundred Dollars (\$1500.00), or as much thereof as may be necessary for the purpose of completing the new school building now under construction in the Unga School District, Third Judicial Division, Territory of Alaska, and an emergency is hereby declared to exist.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. That the sum of Fifteen Hundred Dollars (\$1500.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of the general funds of the Territory not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose

of completing the new school building now in course of construction, in the Unga School District, Third Judicial Division, Territory of Alaska.

That the money by this Act appropriated shall be expended under the direction of the Commissioner of Education, and shall be paid by the Treasurer of the Territory of Alaska, upon warrants drawn upon him by the Commissioner of Education, specifying the purpose for which such warrants are drawn. How expended.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.

## CHAPTER 28.

### AN ACT

[H. B. 52]

For the rehabilitation, construction and maintenance of telephone lines on the Seward Peninsula, between Nome and Kougarok, between Nome-Solomon-Council and Golovin, between Solomon and Bluff, between Candle and Deering, and between Candle and Keewalik; making an appropriation of Four Thousand Dollars (\$4,000.00), therefor, and declaring an emergency.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. That the sum of Four Thousand Dollars (\$4,000.00), is hereby appropriated, or so much thereof as may be required to be expended by the Territorial Board of Road Commissioners in cooperation with the Alaska Road Commission for the purpose of rehabilitating, constructing, and maintaining permanent telephone lines and connections between Nome and Kougarok, between Nome-Solomon-Council and Golovin, between Solomon and Bluff, between Candle and Deering, and between Candle and Keewalik, on the Appropriation
