

CHAPTER 35.

AN ACT

[H. B. 36]

To assist the City of Douglas in repairing and extending the school building and in otherwise extending aid for school purposes, making an appropriation therefor, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. Whereas a large portion of the taxable property of the City of Douglas was destroyed and heavy burdens of replacement have been placed upon said city by the severe conflagration which occurred in the said city on October 10, 1926,

Appropriation to City of Douglas for repair of school house.

Therefore the sum of Thirty-Five Hundred Dollars (\$3500.00) is hereby appropriated for the purpose of repairing, extending the school building and otherwise meeting the school budget of the school year of 1926 and 1927.

Section 2. The sum appropriated in Section 1 of this Act shall be paid by the Territorial Treasurer to the Treasurer of the City of Douglas for the purposes stated and when expended must be accounted for by proper vouchers submitted to the Territorial Treasurer; Provided that the Territorial Treasurer shall deduct from other sums due the said City of Douglas for any failure by the City of Douglas or its school board to comply with this requirement.

Section 3. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
