

## CHAPTER 37.

## AN ACT

[H. B. 10]

Amending Section 1 of Chapter 37 Session Laws of 1921 as amended by Chapter 70 of the Session Laws of 1923, being an Act to provide for the maintenance of public schools in incorporated towns and incorporated school districts.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. Eighty-five per centum of the total amount expended for maintenance of the public elementary schools and high schools, including normal high schools, within the limits of any incorporated town, city or incorporated school district now existing or hereafter established, as the Legislature may from time to time by law direct, shall be refunded to the school fund of said incorporated town, city or incorporated school district from the moneys of the Territory as hereinafter set forth; provided, that no expense incurred for the construction of new buildings, or for repair, alterations or improvement of buildings or for the purchasing of building sites or other real estate, shall be considered expenses of maintenance within the meaning of this Act; provided, further that in incorporated towns whose public schools provide for the education of children residing outside the corporate limits of such towns, a tuition fee of Thirty (\$30.00) Dollars annually for each pupil residing outside the corporate limits and attending school a minimum of 140 days in any one school year shall be chargeable and paid by the Territory of Alaska from the school fund into the Treasury of the incorporated town. A report by the school board of such incorporated town or towns of the names and period of attendance of such children to be made to the Commissioner of Education at the close of each school year and payment shall be made as provided in Sec-

tion 5 of this Act; provided, further, that no incorporated town, city or incorporated school district shall receive more than Thirty Thousand (\$30,000.00) Dollars from the Territory under the provisions of this Act during any one school year of not less than nine school months, and in addition thereto not more than Fifteen Hundred (\$1,500.00) Dollars for the maintenance of a normal high school; and provided further, that no incorporated town, city or incorporated school district shall receive more than an amount equal to 85 per cent of the amount of expenditures as incurred by such incorporated town, city, or incorporated school district during the school year 1926 and 1927; and provided, further, that after the school year ending 1922 no part of any appropriation shall be available for the maintenance of normal high schools, unless a special appropriation is made for that purpose.

Section 2. All Acts or parts of Acts in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

## CHAPTER 38.

### AN ACT

[H. B. 7]

To stimulate interest in agricultural development, animal industry, home economics, mining and manufacturing in the Territory of Alaska, and providing funds for annual fairs within the Territory, and for exhibits to be displayed outside the Territory, prescribing rules governing the same, appropriating money therefor, repealing Chapter 31, Laws of 1925, and declaring an emergency.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. That Agricultural and Industrial Fair Associations, incorporated under the laws of the Territory of Alaska, may receive Territorial aid in con-
