

a period of not more than one year for a second or other offense, or both such fine and imprisonment, in the discretion of the Court.

Section 5. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.

CHAPTER 49.

AN ACT

[S. B. 27]

Authorizing the Territorial Board of Road Commissioners for Alaska to expend a sum not to exceed Twenty-Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500.00) annually, to be taken from the moneys appropriated for the construction, repair and maintenance of roads, trails and bridges and ferries and which may be allotted to the Second Division of Alaska at this session of the Territorial Legislature for the purpose of paying to the City of Nome, Alaska, the sum of Twenty-Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500.00) annually for the purpose of relieving said City of Nome of its obligation and agreement of December 22, 1917, with the War Department to pay annually the said sum of Twenty-Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500.00) for the maintenance and improvement of the Nome harbor, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That the Territorial Board of Road Commissioners of Alaska is hereby authorized to expend out of the moneys appropriated at this session of the Territorial Legislature for the construction and maintenance of roads, trails, bridges and ferries in the Territory of Alaska and which may be allotted to the Second Judicial Division of Alaska, the sum of Twenty-Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500.00) annually, or so much thereof as may be necessary, for the purpose of paying to the said city of Nome the sum of Twenty-Five

Annual payment to the City of Nome for maintenance Nome harbor.

Hundred Dollars (\$2,500.00) annually to relieve said City of Nome of its obligation and agreement of date December 22, 1917, with the War Department to pay annually the sum of Twenty-Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500.00) towards the maintenance and improvement of the harbor of said city of Nome.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall be effective immediately upon its passage and approval.

CHAPTER 50.

AN ACT

[H. B. 85]

To amend Section 2, Chapter 35 of the Session Laws of Alaska, 1919.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. Section 2, Chapter 35, of the Session Laws of Alaska, 1919, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 2. The Governor of Alaska shall also designate or appoint one physician and sanitarian in good standing and licensed to practice medicine in the Territory of Alaska in each Judicial Division, where the Commissioner of Health does not reside, as an Assistant Commissioner of Health. They shall hold office for the term of two (2) years, and until their successors are appointed and qualified, unless sooner removed by the Governor of Alaska, and shall receive an annual salary of Six Hundred Dollars (\$600.00) payable monthly from the Territorial Treasury out of moneys not otherwise appropriated.
