

CHAPTER 51.

AN ACT

[H. B. 62]

To provide for the construction of tramways and water ways on the Portage between the Yukon and the Kuskokwim Rivers, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That the Federal Board of Road Commissioners for Alaska, with the consent and approval of the Territorial Board of Road Commissioners, are hereby authorized and empowered to construct and equip tramways and water ways, and to clean out the sloughs, lakes and streams connecting the Yukon River and intermediary lakes with the Kuskokwim River at the place known as the "Portage", being a place below Holy Cross; Provided the Federal Board of Road Commissioners, known as the Alaska Road Commission, shall contribute not less than two-thirds of the amount required to carry out the purpose of this Act.

Tramways and waterways between Yukon and Kuskokwim Rivers.

Alaska Road Commission to contribute two-thirds expense.

Section 2. That, when constructed, the tramways shall be, until otherwise provided for by law, under the management, control and regulation of the Federal Board of Road Commissioners.

Section 3. For the purpose of carrying out the provisions of this Act, there is hereby appropriated from the general funds of the Territory, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary for the construction of such tramways and water ways.

Appropriation.

Section 4. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
