

## CHAPTER 52.

## AN ACT

[H. B. 77]

Making appropriation for the marking of the boat channel on "The Bar" in Gastineau Channel and declaring an emergency.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. That the sum of One Thousand (\$1,000.00) Dollars is hereby appropriated out of the funds allotted to the First Division for the construction of Roads and trails for the construction and maintenance of appropriate markers between the beacons on the Gastineau Channel Bar to be expended under the direction of the Territorial Board of Road Commissioners.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall be in full force and effect on and after its passage and approval.

## CHAPTER 53.

## AN ACT

[H. B. 74]

To authorize the Governor to employ a veterinarian, to make an appropriation therefor, and declaring an emergency.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. The Governor is hereby authorized either independently or in cooperation with the United States Bureau of Biological Survey or any State University or like institution to employ a veterinarian for such period or periods as he may find to the best advantage, and to fix the compensation for such services. The purpose of such appointment shall be to aid in the development of the industry of raising fur.

Section 2. The duties of the veterinarian shall be as follows: Duties of veterinarian.

(a) To visit the fur farms of the Territory, study the problems incident to commercial raising of fur and advise the fur farmers in matters pertaining to breeding and care of fur bearing animals and the prevention and cure of diseases thereof.

(b) To work under the direction of the Governor.

(c) To make reports to the Governor at such times as the latter shall require and transmit such data from time to time as shall be of value to the industry, and shall sum up such reports for the 1929 Legislature.

Section 3. There is hereby appropriated from the moneys of the Territorial Treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000.00) or so much thereof as shall be necessary, to be paid by the Treasurer on vouchers approved by the Governor, provided that Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), or so much as may be found necessary of the above appropriation, shall be available for furnishing printed matter to fur farms on the subject of disease of fur bearing animals. Appropriation.

Section 4. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval.
