

mail service rendered, segregating the sum according to the three classes herein mentioned.

(d) The gross expenses and the gross earnings of the route covered.

(e) Such vouchers or other data as the Governor may require.

Section 6. The sum of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) is hereby appropriated from any monies in the Territorial Treasury not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of carrying out the provisions of this Act.

Section 7. The Governor is hereby authorized to expend from this appropriation a sum of money not to exceed One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for the advertising for such bids or offers in accordance with the provisions of this Act.

Section 8. That the Governor is authorized to arrange with the Postal Department for the dispatch<sup>Mail.</sup> and service of mail to be carried.

Section 9. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall be in effect immediately upon its passage and approval.

## CHAPTER 58.

### AN ACT

[H. B. 26]

Making an appropriation for the Alaska Agricultural College and School of Mines, and declaring an emergency.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. That there is hereby appropriated from the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska the sum of One Hundred Thirty-Five Thousand, Three Hundred <sup>Appropriation for Agriculture College.</sup>

and Fifty Dollars, (\$135,350.00), to the Alaska Agricultural College and School of Mines to be expended by such corporation in the maintenance and construction of necessary buildings, and conduct of the College established by Chapter Sixty-Two (62) of the Session Laws of Alaska, 1917, during the school years 1927-1928 and 1928-1929.

Section 2. That of the sum hereby appropriated, Ten Thousand Dollars, (\$10,000.00) shall be available for the purchase of new equipment for the power plant and construction of a water storage tank. Forty Thousand Dollars (\$40,000.00) shall be available for the construction of a dormitory and equipment of same. One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) shall be available for increased agricultural projects.

Section 3. Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) thereof shall be available for printing and binding volume No. 1, Miscellaneous Publication of the Alaska Agricultural College and School of Mines, being the Bibliography of Alaskan Literature, 1724-1924, prepared and edited by James Wickersham. The President of the college is hereby authorized to cause the said manuscript to be printed, published and bound, and the expense thereof shall be paid by the Territorial Treasurer out of this appropriation on warrants drawn by the President of the college. The books so delivered to the college may be sold by the college at a standard price to be fixed by the President thereof and the money so obtained therefrom placed in the library fund in said college and the President may also dispose of other volumes by presenting them to other colleges and institutions in exchange for books received from such other colleges and institutions. The President of the College with the consent and approval of the Board of Regents is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with James Wickersham to carry out the purpose of this section.

Section 4. The balance of the appropriation hereby provided shall be available for the maintenance, improvements and conduct of the college. All of above sums shall be available whenever requested by the Board of Regents of said corporation.

Section 5. That during the period covered by the school years 1927-1928, and 1928-1929, no indebtedness or obligation shall be incurred by said Agricultural College and School of Mines over and above the amount appropriated by this Act. Amount of expenditures limited.

Section 6. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.

## CHAPTER 59.

### AN ACT

[H. B. 89]

To amend Chapter 31, Session Laws of 1921, as amended by Chapter 101, Session Laws of 1923, as amended by Chapter 70, Session Laws of 1925, being an Act to establish a system of license taxation, and declaring an emergency.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. That Section 1 of Chapter 31 of the Laws of 1921, as amended by Chapter 101, Session Laws of 1923, as amended by Chapter 70, Session Laws of 1925, is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

“Section 1. Any person, firm or corporation prosecuting, or attempting to prosecute, any of the following lines of business,\* or who shall employ any of the following appliances, in the Territory of Alaska, shall apply for and obtain a license and pay for said license, for the respective lines of business and appliances, as follows:
