

## CHAPTER 62.

## AN ACT

[H. B. 96]

To authorize the Commissioner of Education to build a school house at Gustavus, Alaska, making an appropriation and declaring an emergency.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. The sum of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00) or so much as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska not otherwise appropriated, for the erection and construction of a public school at Strawberry Point, otherwise known as Gustavus, Alaska. School house at Gustavus.

Section 2. The sum of this Act appropriated shall be expended under the direction of the Commissioner of Education, and shall be paid by the Treasurer of the Territory of Alaska upon warrants drawn upon the Treasurer by said Commissioner of Education, specifying the purpose for which such warrants are drawn.

Section 3. The Commissioner of Education is hereby authorized to cause plans for such school building with quarters for teacher if deemed advisable, to be prepared, to designate the location of such building, provide for the purchase and transportation of the material for such construction and to make such contract for the erection of the building as he finds proper. Plans, location and construction.

Section 4. No part of the sum hereby appropriated, or of any other Territorial moneys may be used for purchase, rental or acquisition of the grounds on which said school house is built, and such ground must be furnished to the Territory without cost to the Territory. Ground to be furnished without cost to Territory.

Section 5. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.

## CHAPTER 63.

### AN ACT

[H. B. 711]

To suspend Chapter 44 Session Laws of 1921 and authorize cooperation between the Territory and the United States in making investigations and in disseminating information with a view to improving conditions in the mining, quarrying and metallurgical industries, and to provide for the inspection of mines and the protection of the lives of miners in the Territory of Alaska, and making an appropriation, and declaring an emergency.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. That the provisions and operation of an Act entitled: "An Act to provide for the appointment of a Mine Inspector and fix his term of office and declaring an emergency" (Chapter 44, 1921) be and the same are hereby suspended for the biennium from March 31, 1927, to March 31, 1929.

Section 2. That the Governor be and he is hereby empowered on behalf of the Territory to cooperate with the heads of any executive departments of the United States in making investigations and in disseminating information with a view to improving conditions in the mining, quarrying, and metallurgical industries and to provide for the inspection of mines and the protection of the lives of miners in the Territory of Alaska; the work contemplated herein to be carried on under the Supervising Mining Engineer of the U. S. Geological Survey and Bureau of Mines for Alaska, and to come within the scope of his duties as fixed by Federal Statutes.
