

CHAPTER 73.

AN ACT

[S. B. 49]

To amend Chapter 16, Section 7, of the Session Laws of Alaska, 1925, relating to the method of choosing juries and prescribing certain of the qualifications of jurors.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That Section 7 of Chapter 16 of the Session Laws of Alaska of the year 1925 be, and the same hereby is, amended by adding thereto a paragraph in words as follows:

“Whenever there is drawn from the jury box the name of a juror then engaged in trying or deliberating upon any other case such name shall be rejected pursuant to the provisions of Section 6 hereof without delaying the completion of the panel.”

CHAPTER 74.

AN ACT

[S. B. 50]

To amend Section 2, Section 3, Section 4, Chapter 18, Session Laws of 1919, and Section 6, Chapter 18, of the Laws of 1919, as amended by Chapter 60, Session Laws of 1923, relative to the establishment and maintenance of schools outside incorporated towns and incorporated school districts, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That Section 2 of Chapter 18 of the Laws of 1919 be amended to read as follows:

“Section 2. All persons qualified to sign said petition shall be qualified to vote at said election. The qualified voters of said school
