

## CHAPTER 76.

## AN ACT

[H. B. 93]

To provide for the appropriation and expenditure of Fifteen Hundred Dollars, (\$1,500.00), or so much as may be necessary, in making up the official flag of Alaska adopted by the Legislature of Alaska from among those entered in the contest held by the American Legion, Department of Alaska; and for the appropriation of One Thousand Dollars, (\$1,000.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary for the purpose of sending the winner of the contest, with an escort, if necessary, to Washington to present the first flag of Alaska to the President of the United States.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. That Fifteen Hundred Dollars, (\$1,500.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary, not otherwise appropriated in the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska, is hereby appropriated for the purpose of making up official flags, and souvenir flags, of Alaska, from the design adopted by the Legislature as the official flag of Alaska.

Section 2. That One Thousand Dollars, (\$1,000.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary, not otherwise appropriated in the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska, is hereby appropriated for the purpose of sending Benny Benson of the Mission School District near Seward, designer of the flag adopted as official, together with an escort to be selected by the Governor from the American Legion, or its auxiliary, or otherwise, to Washington to present the first flag of Alaska to the President of the United States, and to provide for his return. Provided, however, that the Governor may give such escort the care and custody of Benny Benson, and authority to arrange the itinerary from the time of leaving Alaska to the time of his return.

Section 3. The Governor is hereby authorized to furnish or exchange official flags with the States of the Union, sub-divisions thereof, and other bodies whenever deemed advisable by the Governor. The Governor is hereby authorized to have small flags made for distribution by the delegation herein provided, and that a part of the money appropriated in Section 1 may be used for the purpose of this Section.

Section 4. These funds are to be expended under the supervision and direction of the Governor.

## CHAPTER 77.

### AN ACT

[H. B. 67]

Relating to the measure and recovery of compensation of injured employees in all businesses, occupations, work, employments, and industries employing five or more employees in the Territory of Alaska, except domestic service, agriculture, dairying and the operation of railroads as common carriers, and relating to the compensation to designated beneficiaries where such injuries result in death, defining and regulating the liability of employers to their employees in connection with such business and industries and repealing all Acts and parts of Acts in conflict with this Act.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. Any person, or persons, partnership, joint stock company, association or corporation employing five or more employees in connection with any business, occupation, work, employment, or industry carried on in this Territory, except domestic service, agriculture, dairying, or the operation of railroads as common carriers who shall not have given notice of his, her, their or its election to reject the provisions of this Act in the manner hereinafter provided, or, who having given such notice, shall, prior to the time

Employers of more than five persons liable for compensation.
