### HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 1.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the House of Representatives, the Senate concurring, that the Standing Committee on Printing and Purchasing be instructed to meet with Printing and Purchasing Committee of the Senate to serve as a Joint Committee on Printing and Purchasing.

### HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 2.

WHEREAS, it has been customary for a Joint Committee of the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Territorial Legislature to visit the Alaska Pioneers' Home, at Sitka, for the purpose of looking into the management thereof and investigating the needs of the institution; and,

WHEREAS, it is necessary and proper that such a visit be made during this session for the purposes hereinabove set forth;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska, the Senate concurring, that a Joint Committee, to consist of five members of the Senate and seven members of the House, be appointed to visit the Alaska Pioneers' Home during this, the eighth, session of the Legislature, with instructions to look into the management of the institution and the needs thereof, and to report its findings and recommendations, if any, to both houses of the Legislature, at an early date.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that said committee shall be authorized, if necessary, to hold hearings, summon witnesses, administer oaths to such witnesses, and take their testimony, as provided by Chapter 6, Session Laws of Alaska, 1917.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Committee be authorized to arrange for the necessary transportation for carrying out the provisions of this Resolution.
