HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 7.

WHEREAS, the daily journal of the House and Senate for May 5th has not been read or approved, and as the validity of all measures passed by the Legislature on that date depends upon the correct journal entries being made at each stage of their consideration;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the House and Senate concurring that the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House in conjunction with the Secretary of the Senate and Chief Clerk of the House, be authorized, after the close of the Session, to revise and arrange said journals in proper and correct order and sign same, and that said President of the Senate and Speaker of the House be allowed the same salary as they are now receiving, as members of the Legislature, for a period of time not to exceed ten days.
