

HOUSE JOINT MEMORIAL NO. 15.

TO THE CONGRESS OF THE UNITED STATES:

Your memorialist, the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska, respectfully represents:

That Section 520 of Title 18 of the Code of Laws of the United States denounces prize fights and bull fights as crimes in the Territories, including Alaska, that it is the desire of the people of the Territory to have complete jurisdiction over the subjects treated in said section of the United States Code of Laws to the end that the Legislature may deal with the subject as it deems proper;

NOW THEREFORE, your memorialist respectfully requests that said Section 520 be repealed as it relates to boxing.
