

# Laws of Alaska

## CHAPTER 1.

### AN ACT

[S. B. 1]

To authorize the Governor of the Territory of Alaska to execute a deed in favor of Geo. A. Gates transferring to him ten acres of the southeast quarter of the southeast quarter of Section eighteen (also described as lot five) township No. sixteen north, range two west, said lands having escheated to the Territory.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. That the Governor of the Territory of Alaska is hereby authorized and directed to execute on behalf of said Territory a deed in favor of Geo. A. Gates of Anchorage, Alaska, transferring to said Gates that portion of the southeast quarter of the southeast quarter of Section eighteen (also described as lot five) township number sixteen north, range two west S. M. to consist of a strip of land along the east side of said lot five, three hundred fifty feet in width beginning at the southeast corner of said Lot No. five and extending north approximately eighty rods, containing ten acres.

Section 2. This authority is given for the reason that pursuant to the terms of settlement of a contest of said Gates to the issuance of patent to one John J. O'Brien in the matter of his homestead entry serial No. 01778 United States land office at Juneau, Alaska, said O'Brien agreed to convey to said Gates upon the issuance of patent, the lands above described in Section one; the same containing the homestead improvements of said Gates. That said agreement was approved by the United States land office and patent to the lands

issued to O'Brien on the 21st day of June, 1922; that in the month of August 1926 the said O'Brien died without having conveyed said lands to said Gates and that by an order of the Probate Court in and for the Wasilla Precinct, Third Judicial Division of Alaska, made on the first day of February 1927, the said lands were escheated to the Territory of Alaska.

## CHAPTER 2.

### AN ACT

[H. B. 1]

To amend Section 1, Chapter 66, of the Session Laws of Alaska of 1923, entitled: "An Act to provide for the obtaining of bids and awarding of contract for printing required of public offices and institutions of the Territory of Alaska [,"] and declaring an emergency.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. That Section 1, Chapter 66 of the Session Laws of Alaska of 1923 be, and the same hereby is amended to read as follows:

Competitive bids

"Section 1. Every public office or institution of the Territory of Alaska shall obtain competitive bids in writing for all printing to be done for said offices or institutions the amount of which shall be in excess of Twenty-Five (\$25.00) Dollars, and the contract for such printing shall be awarded to the lowest bidder. Provided, however, that when immediate delivery or performance is required by public exigency and the obtaining of competitive bids is not practicable, such competitive bids shall not be required, but an affidavit to that effect, made by the officer requiring such printing, must accompany the voucher covering the payment for such printing; provided further, that all calls for
