

## CHAPTER 105.

## AN ACT

[S. B. 80]

To authorize the collection and storing of objects of natural history and to make appropriation for such purposes.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. That the Alaska Agricultural College and School of Mines is hereby authorized to collect and store the bones and other remains of the mammoth, mastodon, horse, bison and other fossil remains of these and other extinct animals which may be found in Alaska in mining and other excavations.

Section 2. There is hereby appropriated out of any money in the Territorial Treasury of Alaska not already appropriated, the sum of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00) for the above authorized purposes.

## CHAPTER 106.

## AN ACT

[H. B. 11]

To provide for the construction of tramways and water ways on the Portage between the Yukon and the Kuskokwim Rivers, and declaring an emergency.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. That the Federal Board of Road Commissioners for Alaska, with the consent and approval of the Territorial Board of Road Commissioners, are hereby authorized and empowered to construct, equip and maintain tramways, dams, derricks and ramps and water ways, and to clean out and dredge the sloughs, lakes and streams connecting the Yukon River and intermediary lakes with the Kuskokwim River at the place known as the "Portage", being a place below Holy
