CHAPTER 107.

AN ACT

[H. B. 22]

To appropriate funds for the erection of an addition to, and the improvement of, the public school house at Bethel, Alaska, making provision for the expenditure of said funds, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. The sum of Four Thousand Dollars (\$4,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any monies in the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska not otherwise appropriated, for the erection and construction of an addition to, and the improvement of, the public school house at and in the Town of Bethel, Alaska, provided however, the sum herein specified shall not be in addition to any other sums otherwise authorized by law. Appropriation for addition Bethel school house. Proviso.

Section 2. The sum by this Act appropriated shall be expended under the direction of the Commissioner of Education, and shall be paid by the Treasurer of the Territory of Alaska upon warrants drawn upon the Treasurer by said Commissioner of Education, specifying the purpose for which warrants are drawn. Appropriation, how expended.

Section 3. The Commissioner of Education is hereby authorized to cause plans for such addition to be prepared, provide for the purchase and transportation of the material for such addition and improvements, and to enter into such contract for the work hereby authorized, as he finds proper, provided however, that all Under supervision Commissioner of Education.

material purchased to carry out the provisions of this Act shall, in so far as practicable, be products of the Territory of Alaska.

Grounds to be donated.

Section 4. No part of the sum hereby appropriated, or any other Territorial monies, may be used for the purchase, rental or acquisition of the grounds on which such addition shall be built, and such grounds must be furnished to the Territory without cost to the Territory.

Emergency.

Section 5. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.

CHAPTER 108.

AN ACT

[H. B. 31]

To appropriate the sum of Seventeen Thousand Two Hundred Dollars (\$17,200.00) to aid shipping in the Territory of Alaska, along the coast of Seward Peninsula, from St. Michaels to Kotzebue, and for the advertising for bids, repealing Chapter 34 Session Laws of 1927 and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Governor may contract for Seward Peninsula shipping.

Section 1. That the Governor of Alaska is authorized to contract to pay a sum of money, not to exceed Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) and not to exceed Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) in any one year, to the owner or charterer of any ship or vessel of American registry, of cargo capacity of not less than forty tons under deck and a passenger capacity of not less than twenty (20) persons and a loaded draft of not to exceed seven (7) feet, and a maximum speed of not less than eight (8) knots per hour, who shall operate such ship or vessel in the coastwise trade, as a common
