

CHAPTER 17.
AN ACT

[S. B. 28]

For the relief of Arthur G. Thompson and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That the sum of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) is hereby appropriated for the payment of Arthur G. Thompson for his services as attorney for the Territory in the matter of the estate of Edward Spahr, deceased, and the Treasurer of the Territory is directed to pay said sum to said Thompson out of funds of the Territory not otherwise appropriated. Appropriation
reimbursing
A. G. Thompson.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval. Emergency.

CHAPTER 18.
AN ACT

[S. B. 29]

To appropriate \$779.00 for R. K. Stewart and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. The sum of \$779.00 is hereby appropriated out of the Treasury of the Territory not otherwise appropriated, to be paid R. K. Stewart as wages for two months services as predatory animal hunter at the rate of \$300.00 per month, and as refund for \$179.00 worth of property lost by him in the wreck of the gasoline boat "Comrade", and the Treasurer of the Territory is authorized to pay such sum to said R. K. Stewart. Appropriation
reimbursing
R. K. Stewart.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared and this Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval. Emergency.
