## CHAPTER 2.

### AN ACT

[H. B. 1]

To amend Section 1, Chapter 66, of the Session Laws of Alaska of 1923, entitled: "An Act to provide for the obtaining of bids and awarding of contract for printing required of public offices and institutions of the Territory of Alaska [,"] and declaring an emergency.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. That Section 1, Chapter 66 of the Session Laws of Alaska of 1923 be, and the same hereby is amended to read as follows:

Competitive bids  
required on all  
printing for  
Territorial  
Government,  
unless—

"Section 1. Every public office or institution of the Territory of Alaska shall obtain competitive bids in writing for all printing to be done for said offices or institutions the amount of which shall be in excess of Twenty-Five (\$25.00) Dollars, and the contract for such printing shall be awarded to the lowest bidder. Provided, however, that when immediate delivery or performance is required by public exigency and the obtaining of competitive bids is not practicable, such competitive bids shall not be required, but an affidavit to that effect, made by the officer requiring such printing, must accompany the voucher covering the payment for such printing; provided further, that all calls for

bids shall be issued at least forty-eight (48) hours before the time set for the closing and receiving of said bids. ["]

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist, <sup>Emergency.</sup> and this Act shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.

### CHAPTER 3.

#### AN ACT

[S. B. 7]

Making an appropriation for the payment of a deficiency in the appropriation for the transportation of pupils within and outside the boundaries of school districts; and declaring an emergency.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. That there be and hereby is appropriated from the general fund of the Territorial Treasury the sum of Two Thousand Two Hundred (\$2,200.00) Dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary to be expended by the Commissioner of Education with the approval of the Governor, for the transportation of pupils both within and outside the boundaries of school districts for the period ending June 30, 1929. <sup>Deficiency, transportation pupils.</sup>

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist <sup>Emergency.</sup> and this Act shall be in force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
