

CHAPTER 20.

AN ACT

[S. B. 34]

Authorizing the Territorial Board of Road Commissioners in cooperation with the Alaska Road Commission, to rehabilitate and maintain the old abandoned U. S. Signal Corps telegraph line between Tanana and Unalakleet to be used as a public telephone line and authorizing the Board to make such expenditures under and from the general road appropriations of the Second and Fourth Divisions, charging to the appropriation of each Division for expenditures made for such work within each Division, provided that during the biennium the total expenditures for such work shall not exceed Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00), and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. The sum of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) is hereby appropriated out of the moneys appropriated at this Session of the Legislature for the construction and maintenance of roads, trails, bridges and ferries which may be allotted to the Second and Fourth Judicial Division of Alaska; or so much thereof as may be required, to be expended by the Territorial Board of Road Commissioners, in cooperation with the Alaska Road Commission, for the purpose of rehabilitating and maintaining the old abandoned U. S. Signal Corps telegraph line between Tanana, Kaltag, and Unalakleet to be used as a public telephone line for the biennium beginning July 1, 1929 and ending June 30, 1931; and authorizing said Board to make such expenditures under and from the general road appropriations of the Second and Fourth Divisions charging same for such work within each Division against the general road fund appropriation for such Division, not to exceed the sum of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) from the Second Division Road fund, and Four Thousand Dollars (\$4,000.00) from the Fourth Division Road fund.

The Board is authorized to purchase such telephones, batteries, etc., as shall be necessary to carry out the purpose of this Act and to promulgate such rules and regulations pertaining to the use and fixing the rates to be charged for services on said line.

Section 2. Payments under this Act shall be made quarterly by the Territorial Treasurer upon vouchers approved by the Alaska Road Commission.

Emergency.

Section 3. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall be effective immediately upon its passage and approval.

CHAPTER 21.

AN ACT

[S. B. 32]

Authorizing the Territorial Board of Road Commissioners for the Territory of Alaska to repair and maintain the Valdez dyke, providing for the payment for said work, authorizing a contribution to the same or similar work if done by the United States, and declaring an emergency to give this Act immediate effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. The Territorial Board of Road Commissioners for the Territory of Alaska are hereby authorized and empowered to repair from time to time as necessary and to maintain during the years 1929 and 1930, or during such portion of said period as may be necessary, the dyke which partially surrounds the city of Valdez, Alaska, and which was built to protect said city and the property therein situated from the waters of the stream flowing from the Valdez Glacier, in the same manner and to the same extent that said Board may repair and maintain any public road in the Territory of Alaska.
