

The Board is authorized to purchase such telephones, batteries, etc., as shall be necessary to carry out the purpose of this Act and to promulgate such rules and regulations pertaining to the use and fixing the rates to be charged for services on said line.

Payments  
quarterly.

Section 2. Payments under this Act shall be made quarterly by the Territorial Treasurer upon vouchers approved by the Alaska Road Commission.

Emergency.

Section 3. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall be effective immediately upon its passage and approval.

## CHAPTER 21.

### AN ACT

[S. B. 32]

Authorizing the Territorial Board of Road Commissioners for the Territory of Alaska to repair and maintain the Valdez dyke, providing for the payment for said work, authorizing a contribution to the same or similar work if done by the United States, and declaring an emergency to give this Act immediate effect.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Appropriation  
repair Valdez

Section 1. The Territorial Board of Road Commissioners for the Territory of Alaska are hereby authorized and empowered to repair from time to time as necessary and to maintain during the years 1929 and 1930, or during such portion of said period as may be necessary, the dyke which partially surrounds the city of Valdez, Alaska, and which was built to protect said city and the property therein situated from the waters of the stream flowing from the Valdez Glacier, in the same manner and to the same extent that said Board may repair and maintain any public road in the Territory of Alaska.

Section 2. That the expense of the repair and maintenance of said dyke shall be paid from the moneys appropriated by the Alaska Territorial Legislature, and allotted to the Third Division of the Territory of Alaska, for the construction and maintenance of roads, trails, bridges and ferries in the Territory of Alaska, and from the funds which said Board may reasonably require to be contributed by the said city of Valdez therefor.

Money from Third Division road fund and Valdez.

Section 3. That during the years 1929 and 1930 said Board shall not expend from said fund for the repair and/or maintenance of said dyke, a sum exceeding Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000.00). No greater portion of said fund shall be expended than shall be necessary for the repair and maintenance of said dyke during the period mentioned.

Limitation.

Section 4. The repair and maintenance of said dyke herein provided for shall be deemed to include the rebuilding or replacement of any portion of said dyke which may hereafter be washed out or destroyed.

Rebuild and replace.

Section 5. In making the expenditures herein authorized, said Board is hereby empowered to enter into cooperative agreement or agreements with the Board of Road Commissioners for Alaska (commonly known as the Alaska Road Commission) for the doing of such work, so that the work may actually be done by or under the supervision of the said Board of Road Commissioners for Alaska and paid for out of the moneys herein authorized to be expended for that purpose and from such funds as may be supplied by said city of Valdez.

Empowered to enter cooperative agreement.

Section 6. That the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00), or so much thereof as may be required or necessary, is hereby appropriated from the moneys in the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of paying or applying

upon any contribution that may be required of the Territory of Alaska, the said city of Valdez, or other local interests, by any Act, resolution and/or other legislative enactment, of the Congress of the United States for the repair, maintenance or rebuilding of said dyke, or for the building or construction of another dyke or other structure for the accomplishment of the same purpose, by the United States or any department, bureau, board, commission or agency thereof, and the Territorial Treasurer of the Territory of Alaska is hereby authorized and directed to pay the said sum hereby appropriated, or so much thereof as may be required or necessary, to the Federal commission, board or agency doing or entrusted with said work immediately upon the passage of the said legislation therefor by the Congress. The said sum hereby appropriated shall remain continuously available until the convening of the regular session of the Alaska Territorial Legislature to be held in the year 1931.

Emergency.

Section 7. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall be effective immediately upon its passage and approval.

## CHAPTER 22.

### AN ACT

[S. B. 41]

To Authorize the Attorney General to employ assistant counsel in certain cases.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. That whenever any cause wherein the Territory is interested shall be pending before any court distant from the capital and in which cause it is necessary for the Territory to be represented by counsel, the Attorney General, with the approval of the Governor, shall have authority to engage some
