

upon any contribution that may be required of the Territory of Alaska, the said city of Valdez, or other local interests, by any Act, resolution and/or other legislative enactment, of the Congress of the United States for the repair, maintenance or rebuilding of said dyke, or for the building or construction of another dyke or other structure for the accomplishment of the same purpose, by the United States or any department, bureau, board, commission or agency thereof, and the Territorial Treasurer of the Territory of Alaska is hereby authorized and directed to pay the said sum hereby appropriated, or so much thereof as may be required or necessary, to the Federal commission, board or agency doing or entrusted with said work immediately upon the passage of the said legislation therefor by the Congress. The said sum hereby appropriated shall remain continuously available until the convening of the regular session of the Alaska Territorial Legislature to be held in the year 1931.

Emergency.

Section 7. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall be effective immediately upon its passage and approval.

## CHAPTER 22.

### AN ACT

[S. B. 41]

To Authorize the Attorney General to employ assistant counsel in certain cases.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. That whenever any cause wherein the Territory is interested shall be pending before any court distant from the capital and in which cause it is necessary for the Territory to be represented by counsel, the Attorney General, with the approval of the Governor, shall have authority to engage some

attorney-at-law to appear for him before such court, in event the Attorney General cannot be present in person, or in event the matter involved is not in his opinion of sufficient importance to justify him in expending the money necessary to attend such court in person. The Attorney General may for such services cause to be paid out of the proper appropriations for his office such sum as he shall deem fair and reasonable, provided, however, that during no one calendar year shall he pay or incur liability for such services in aggregate to exceed Five Hundred Dollars. Limitation.

CHAPTER 23.  
AN ACT

[S. B. 43]

To repeal Chapter 11 of the 1915 Session Laws of the Territory of Alaska providing for local self-government in certain native villages and Chapter 25 of the 1917 Session Laws of the Territory of Alaska amendatory thereof.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. That Chapter 11 of the 1915 Session Laws of the Territory of Alaska and Chapter 25 of the 1917 Session Laws of the Territory of Alaska are hereby repealed. Repeal.

CHAPTER 24.  
AN ACT

[S. B. 45]

To repeal Chapter 68 of the 1913 Session Laws of the Territory of Alaska relative to locating townsites near navigable rivers.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. That Chapter 68 of the 1913 Session Laws of the Territory of Alaska is hereby repealed. Repeal.
