

CHAPTER 26.

AN ACT

[H. B. 18]

To appropriate funds for the protection of the town of Hyder, Alaska, from the encroachments of the Salmon River, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Appropriation
protect Hyder
from Salmon
River.

Section 1. The sum of Seven Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$7500.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska, not otherwise appropriated, for the immediate performance of such work, labor or construction as may tend to restrain the Salmon River from encroaching upon the town of Hyder, Alaska, now in imminent danger therefrom.

Work may be
performed thru
cooperation.

Section 2. The sum of this Act appropriated shall be expended under the direction of the Territorial Board of Road Commissioners, using such other means or other organization as it may find necessary at Hyder, Alaska, and shall be paid by the Treasurer of the Territory of Alaska upon warrants drawn on the Treasurer, specifying the purpose for which such warrants are drawn.

Emergency.

Section 3. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall be effective immediately upon its passage and approval.
