Section 8. An emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval. Emergency.

CHAPTER 34.

AN ACT

[H. B. 42]

To accept the benefits of the provisions of the Act of Congress approved January 21st, 1929, and entitled "An Act making an additional grant of land for the support and maintenance of the Agricultural College and School of Mines of the Territory of Alaska, and for other purposes," and to provide the instrumentalities carrying out the purposes of said Act.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. The grants of land authorized by Act of Congress entitled "An Act making an additional grant of lands for the support and maintenance of the Agricultural College and School of Mines of the Territory of Alaska, and for other purposes" approved January 21st, 1929, are hereby accepted by the Territory of Alaska in accordance with and subject to all the conditions of the above specified Act. Acceptance by Territory of Federal land grants.

Section 2. The Alaska Agricultural College and School of Mines is hereby designated as the beneficiary under the provisions of said Act. Alaska Agricultural College beneficiary.

Board of trustees to select lands and sell or lease.

Section 3. The Territory of Alaska hereby authorizes the Board of Trustees of the Alaska Agricultural College and School of Mines, under the direction and subject to the approval of the Secretary of the Interior, to select the lands granted to the Territory of Alaska by said Act, and to sell or lease the same, and cover the proceeds derived therefrom into the Treasury of the Territory, all in conformity with the provisions and conditions of said Act.

Funds derived covered into treasury.

Treasurer establish separate fund.

Section 4. The Territorial Treasurer is hereby required to establish a separate fund in which all moneys derived from the sale or lease of the lands granted under said Act are to be kept, and the same shall be invested as specified under the provisions of Section 6 of said Act. The money in said fund shall be disbursed by the Treasurer of the Territory to the Treasurer of said Agricultural College and School of Mines upon vouchers approved by the President and Treasurer of the said institution specifying the purpose for which such money paid on any particular voucher is to be used and showing it is to be used in conformity with the provisions of said Act of January 21st, 1929.

CHAPTER 35.

AN ACT

[S. B. 25]

To provide for the erection and construction, or for the purchase, repair, alteration and improvement, of a public school house at Tanana, Alaska, making an appropriation therefor, and giving the Act immediate effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Power to erect or purchase school house at Tanana.

Section 1. The Commissioner of Education of the Territory of Alaska is hereby granted the authority and power to cause to be erected and constructed, or
