

Board of trustees to select lands and sell or lease.

Section 3. The Territory of Alaska hereby authorizes the Board of Trustees of the Alaska Agricultural College and School of Mines, under the direction and subject to the approval of the Secretary of the Interior, to select the lands granted to the Territory of Alaska by said Act, and to sell or lease the same, and cover the proceeds derived therefrom into the Treasury of the Territory, all in conformity with the provisions and conditions of said Act.

Funds derived covered into treasury.

Treasurer establish separate fund.

Section 4. The Territorial Treasurer is hereby required to establish a separate fund in which all moneys derived from the sale or lease of the lands granted under said Act are to be kept, and the same shall be invested as specified under the provisions of Section 6 of said Act. The money in said fund shall be disbursed by the Treasurer of the Territory to the Treasurer of said Agricultural College and School of Mines upon vouchers approved by the President and Treasurer of the said institution specifying the purpose for which such money paid on any particular voucher is to be used and showing it is to be used in conformity with the provisions of said Act of January 21st, 1929.

How may be paid out.

## CHAPTER 35.

### AN ACT

[S. B. 25]

To provide for the erection and construction, or for the purchase, repair, alteration and improvement, of a public school house at Tanana, Alaska, making an appropriation therefor, and giving the Act immediate effect.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Power to erect or purchase school house at Tanana.

Section 1. The Commissioner of Education of the Territory of Alaska is hereby granted the authority and power to cause to be erected and constructed, or

to purchase, alter, repair and improve, a public school house at Tanana, Alaska, at any time on or before January 1, 1930. Full discretion is hereby granted to said Commissioner of Education to either cause such school house to be erected and constructed, or to purchase a building heretofore constructed and make the necessary and reasonable alterations, repairs and improvements in and to the same so as to properly fit it for use as such school house, or to do neither, as in the opinion of the Commissioner of Education may be proper, due care being taken to provide reasonably adequate school facilities for the children properly attending the public school maintained at Tanana, Alaska. Provided, that in the event of the purchase of a building and grounds as herein provided, not more than \$2500.00 shall be paid therefor.

Section 2. That the sum of Four Thousand Dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the moneys in the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska not otherwise appropriated, for the erection and construction, or for the purchase, alteration, repair and improvement of such public school house at Tanana, Alaska.

Section 3. The moneys hereby appropriated shall be paid out or expended by or under the direction of the Commissioner of Education, and shall be paid by the Treasurer of the Territory of Alaska upon submission of vouchers drawn and approved by said Commissioner of Education specifying the purpose or purposes for which such vouchers are drawn.

Section 4. The Commissioner of Education is authorized to cause plans to be drawn for any school house that may be erected and constructed hereunder, designate the location thereof and the character of construction and equipment, and call for bids for construction. The construction of any school house here-

under shall at all times be under the control and supervision of the Commissioner of Education.

Ground must be donated.

Section 5. No part of the moneys hereby appropriated, or of any other Territorial moneys, may be used for the purchase, rental or acquisition of the grounds on which any school house constructed hereunder shall be built, or for the yards or grounds adjacent thereto, and all such grounds must be furnished without cost to the Territory. Provided, however, that if a building is purchased hereunder, the ground on which it is situated and the reasonably necessary surrounding yards and grounds may be purchased with such building.

Proviso.

Fixing total expenditure.

Section 6. That the sum hereby appropriated shall not be in addition to any money otherwise appropriated by the Territory for the construction of school buildings, and shall cover the entire cost of such construction and erection, or of the purchase, repair, improvement and alteration, as the case may be, of a public school house at Tanana, Alaska.

Emergency.

Section 7. This Act shall be effective immediately upon its passage and approval.

## CHAPTER 36.

### AN ACT

[S. B. 38]

To amend Section 903 of the Compiled Laws of Alaska, relative to the verification of pleadings.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. That Section 903 of the Compiled Laws of Alaska be, and the same hereby is, amended so as to read as follows:

Verification of pleadings by party.

Sec. 903. Every pleading shall be subscribed by the party or his attorney, and, except
