

CHAPTER 41.

AN ACT

[S. B. 57]

For refund of trap tax to Tenning Carlson, and giving this Act immediate effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Refund trap tax.

Section 1. That there is hereby appropriated from the moneys in the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska not otherwise appropriated, the sum of Two Hundred (\$200.00) Dollars to be paid to Tenning Carlson of Latouche, Alaska, as refund of tax for salmon trap No. 27-426, the area embracing the location of said trap having been closed to trap fishing by regulations of the United States Bureau of Fisheries after the issuance of said license and the payment by said Tenning Carlson to the Territorial Treasurer of said tax of Two Hundred (\$200.00) Dollars.

Emergency.

Section 2. This Act shall be effective immediately upon its passage and approval.

CHAPTER 42.

AN ACT

[S. B. 64]

To amend Section 4, of Chapter 31, of the Session Laws of Alaska of the year 1917 relative to the rescue and relief of lost persons.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That Section 4, of Chapter 31 of the Session Laws of the Territory of Alaska of the year 1917, be and the same hereby is amended so as to read as follows:

“Section 4. Every United States Commissioner shall receive for his services in sending

out any search or relief party, the sum of Ten (\$10.00) Dollars upon vouchers in duplicate, properly signed and witnessed by two witnesses, which vouchers, together with vouchers of the search or relief party, shall be mailed to the Territorial Treasurer within five (5) days after the return of said search or relief party."

CHAPTER 43.

AN ACT

[S. B. 62]

To amend Section 2, Chapter 73, of the Session Laws of the Territory of Alaska of the year 1923, relative to domestic corporations.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That subparagraph "III" of subsection "(a)" of Section 2 of Chapter 73 of the Session Laws of the Territory of Alaska of the year 1923 be and the same hereby is amended so as to read as follows:

"III. The amount of capital stock, how the same shall be paid in, and what proportion, if any, is preferred stock and its preferences, in conformity with Section 5 of this Act. Provided, however, that in case all of the shares of the capital stock are without any nominal or par value, the amount of the capital stock need not be stated; and in case a part of the shares are without any nominal or par value, it shall be necessary to state only the amount of the capital stock to which has been assigned a nominal or par value."
