

## CHAPTER 47.

## AN ACT

[H. B. 74]

Making an appropriation for the marking the boat channel on "The Bar" in Gastineau Channel and declaring an emergency.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. That the sum of Seven Hundred Fifty (\$750.00) Dollars is hereby appropriated out of the funds allotted to the First Division for the construction of roads and trails for the construction and maintenance of appropriate markers between the beacons on the Gastineau Channel Bar to be expended under the direction of the Territorial Board of Road Commissioners.

Appropriation to mark Gastineau Bar.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall be in full force and effect on and after its passage and approval.

## CHAPTER 48.

## AN ACT

[H. B. 75]

To appropriate \$30.63 for Johnson and Higgins of Washington, Inc. and declaring an emergency.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. That the sum of \$30.63 is hereby appropriated out of the Treasury of the Territory, from funds not otherwise appropriated for the reimbursement of Johnson and Higgins of Washington, Inc. for payment of general average loss assessed against freight shipped by the Territory on Motor Ship "Norco" in November, 1926, and the Treasurer of the Territory

Reimburse Johnson & Higgins.

is directed to pay said sum to said Johnson and Higgins of Washington, Inc.

Emergency.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.

## CHAPTER 49.

### AN ACT

[H. B. 77]

To appropriate \$21,000.00 for payment of allowances to aid aged residents for the quarter beginning April 1st and ending June 30th, 1929, and declaring an emergency.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Deficiency appropriation for aged residents.

Section 1. That the sum of \$21,000.00 is appropriated out of the moneys in the Treasury of the Territory for the purpose of paying the allowance to aged residents pursuant to Chapter 64 of the Laws of 1915 as amended, for the quarter beginning April 1st and ending June 30th, 1929.

Emergency.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval.
