

CHAPTER 54.

AN ACT

Authorizing the Territorial Treasurer to make refunds of moneys paid as licenses for fish traps in certain cases where such traps are not driven or operated.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. That any person who shall in good faith pay to the Territorial Treasurer the tax or license or license fee required by law for the construction or operation of any fish trap, and such person is thereafter prevented from driving or operating such fish trap by reason of Governmental Act, provision, rule or regulation, such person shall be entitled to receive from the Territorial Treasurer upon application refund of the money so paid to the Territorial Treasurer as license tax or fee for the construction and operation of said trap; and that the Territorial Treasurer be and he hereby is authorized and empowered to make refunds of such moneys to the proper persons in all cases coming within the provisions of this Act, the said Territorial Treasurer being hereby granted the discretion to determine whether or not any applicant for refund hereunder shall be entitled thereto. Provided, however, that nothing in this Act shall authorize the refund of any such tax when the person or corporation paying the tax was prevented from constructing or operating such trap by reason of storms, inclement weather or any other cause except those above mentioned.

Authorizing trap tax refund for unused traps.

Discretion given Treasurer to pass upon claim. Proviso.
