

CHAPTER 59.

AN ACT

[S. B. 75]

To appropriate \$741.31 to defray certain health and sanitation expenses incurred at Fairbanks, Alaska, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That the sum of \$741.31 be and the same hereby is appropriated out of the general funds of the Territory of Alaska to defray the expenses incurred in connection with the care and treatment for smallpox of James Gabriel and Moses Kinegak at Fairbanks, Alaska during the months of December 1928 and January 1929; and the Treasurer of the Territory of Alaska is hereby authorized to pay out said sum or so much thereof as may be necessary upon vouchers to be approved by the Governor.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and approval.

CHAPTER 60.

AN ACT

[S. B. 77]

To amend Section 2554 Compiled Laws of the Territory of Alaska, relative to filing of transcript on appeal from a judgment of conviction in a Justice's Court, in a criminal action.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That Section 2554, Compiled Laws of the Territory of Alaska, is hereby amended to read as follows:

appeal from
justices' courts
in criminal
action.

Section 2554. That when an appeal is allowed, the Justice must make the proper transcript and deliver it to the Clerk of the District Court within ten days after the appeal is allowed, or deposit the same in the United States postoffice addressed to the Clerk of the District Court within such time.

CHAPTER 61.

AN ACT

[S. B. 78]

To insure the lawful conduct of elections in incorporated cities, incorporated school districts and school districts outside incorporated cities and incorporated school districts by applying the provisions of Section 406 of Compiled Laws of Alaska to such elections.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Sec. 406 Com-
piled Laws made
applicable to
all elections.

Section 1. That the provisions of Section 406 of Compiled Laws of Alaska shall apply to all elections, whether general or special, held in any incorporated city, incorporated school district or school district outside of an incorporated city for the purpose of electing local officers whether of the city or the school district or for any other legal purpose.
