

of Alaska may be removed therefrom, or shipped out of the Territory of Alaska by any person or corporation, when, and in such manner, as the Secretary of War may authorize or direct.

Section 2. The provisions of Chapter 35 of the Session Laws of the Territory of Alaska of 1913, and Chapter 47 of the Session Laws of the Territory of Alaska of 1915, shall not apply to the removal or shipment out of the Territory of such dead bodies. Other specified laws not to apply.

Section 3. An emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval. Emergency.

## CHAPTER 71.

### AN ACT

[H. B. 68]

To reimburse Norman L. Wimpler for traveling expenses paid by him on behalf of the Territory in connection with making mining investigations in Alaska.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. Whereas, Norman L. Wimpler was engaged as placer mining engineer in making mining investigations in Alaska during the year 1926 under the terms of the cooperative arrangement authorized by Chapter 33, Session Laws of 1925 (H. B. No. 42), and, Appropriation reimbursing Norman L. Wimpler for traveling expenses disallowed by U. S. Geological Survey.

Whereas, he was directed by the Supervising Mining Engineer of the Geological Survey to proceed from his domicile at Berkeley, California, to Alaska in May 1926, and did so proceed at the expense of the Geological Survey, and with the express understanding

that at the end of the field season his traveling expenses would be allowed for his return trip from Alaska to Berkeley, California, and

Whereas, by reason of an error in his written authorization to travel that was issued by the Geological Survey at Washington in June, 1926 no provisions was made therein for authority to travel outside of Alaska, in consequence of which error his travel expense vouchers covering his return journey from Alaska to Berkeley, California, made in October 1926 and amounting to the sum of One Hundred Fifty-five (\$155.43) Dollars and Forty-three Cents were finally disallowed by the Geological Survey and has never been paid, and

Whereas, the said Norman L. Wimpler was thereby compelled to personally assume the entire expense of the said journey made while on official duty in connection with making mining investigations in Alaska and has not been reimbursed for the same nor any part thereof, the sum of One Hundred Fifty-five (\$155.43) Dollars and Forty-three cents out of the moneys of the Territory not otherwise appropriated is hereby appropriated as reimbursement to the said Norman L. Wimpler, and the Treasurer of the Territory is hereby instructed to pay said sum to said Wimpler.

## CHAPTER 72.

### AN ACT

[H. B. 2]

Creating a Territorial Boxing Commission, defining its powers and duties, making an appropriation for carrying out the provisions of this Act, prescribing penalties and declaring an emergency.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. There is hereby created a Commission, to be known as the Territorial Boxing Commission,
