

## CHAPTER 79.

## AN ACT

[H. B. 80]

To authorize the Territorial Treasurer to make refund of overpayment for fish trap licenses to Alaska General Fisheries, Alaska Year Round Canneries Co., Inc., Cook Inlet Packing Co., Edward Gustan, R. H. Koch and E. L. Everett, Kodiak Island Fishing and Packing Co., Libby, McNeill & Libby, North Coast Packing Co., Norstedt & Wick, and Paul Shadura, making an appropriation therefor and declaring an emergency.

Whereas, The Legislature of the Territory of Alaska at its 1927 session passed an Act which was approved and became effective on May 5, 1927 reducing the fish trap license charge on hand driven beach traps from \$200 to \$50, and

Whereas, It appears that the intention of the Act was to make a uniform charge for hand driven beach traps for the fishing season of 1927 as well as for subsequent seasons, and

Whereas, Alaska General Fisheries paid \$200 for hand trap No. 27-537 and \$200 for hand trap No. 27-597, Alaska Year Round Canneries Co., Inc., paid \$200 for hand trap No. 27-422 and \$200 for hand trap No. 27-423, Cook Inlet Packing Co. paid \$200 for hand trap No. 27-584, \$200 for hand trap No. 27-585 and \$200 for hand trap No. 27-586, Edward Gustan paid \$200 for hand trap No. 27-646, R. H. Koch and E. L. Everett paid \$200 for hand trap No. 27-425 and \$200 for hand trap No. 27-424, Kodiak Island Fishing and Packing Co. paid \$200 for hand trap No. 27-589, Libby, McNeill & Libby paid \$200 for hand trap No. 27-250, \$200 for hand trap No. 27-255 and \$200 for hand trap No. 27-259, North Coast Packing Co. paid \$200 for hand trap No. 27-547, \$200 for hand trap No. 27-548, \$200 for hand trap No. 27-549, \$200 for hand trap No. 27-550, \$200 for hand trap No. 27-551, Norstedt and

Wick paid \$200 for hand trap No. 27-800 and Paul Shadura paid \$200 for hand trap No. 27-038, each and every one of said license payments being in excess of the amount provided to be paid by the said Act of the Territorial Legislature at its 1927 session, Therefore,

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Refund on  
certain fish  
trap licenses.

Section 1. That the Treasurer of the Territory of Alaska is hereby authorized to refund to Alaska General Fisheries the sum of \$300, to Alaska Year Round Canneries Co., Inc. the sum of \$300, to Cook Inlet Packing Co. the sum of \$450, to Edward Gustan the sum of \$150, to R. H. Koch and E. L. Everett the sum of \$300, to Kodiak Island Fishing and Packing Co. the sum of \$150, to Libby, McNeill & Libby the sum of \$450, to North Coast Packing Co. the sum of \$750, to Norstedt and Wick the sum of \$150 and to Paul Shadura the sum of \$150 out of the moneys of the Territorial Treasury not otherwise appropriated.

How paid.

Appropriation.

Section 2. The sum of \$3150 is hereby appropriated out of any funds in the Territorial Treasury not otherwise appropriated for the purpose of carrying out the provisions of this Act.

Emergency.

Section 3. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall be in full force and effect immediately after its passage and approval.
