

CHAPTER 80.

AN ACT

[S. B. 58]

Authorizing the Territorial Board of Road Commissioners, in cooperation with the Alaska Road Commission, to construct, rehabilitate or purchase, maintain, operate and regulate traffic over telephone lines between Haycock and Candle, and between Shelton and Taylor on Seward Peninsula, making an appropriation therefor, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. The sum of Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated, one half or Seven Thousand Five Hundred (\$7,500.00) Dollars out of the moneys in the general Treasury of the Territory of Alaska, as are not otherwise appropriated, and one half or Seven Thousand Five Hundred (\$7,500) Dollars out of the allotment of the Second Division appropriated for the construction of roads and trails, for the purpose of construction, rehabilitation or purchase, and maintenance of a system of telephone lines between Haycock and Candle and between Shelton and Taylor on Seward Peninsula.

Appropriation for telephone lines on Seward Peninsula, funds where derived.

Section 2. The Board, in cooperation with the Alaska Road Commission, is hereby authorized to enter into agreement with the owners of any privately owned lines along the said routes for the rehabilitation or purchase of existing systems if in their judgment such arrangements will be satisfactory; Provided, however, that from any rehabilitation of any telephone lines receiving benefit under this Act, and from any expenditures for such rehabilitation which are termed capital expenditures, there shall accrue to the Territory a permanent equity in such lines accordingly; and provided further that over such lines no charge shall be made which may, or shall pertain to movement of local boats, or mail, or airplanes or to business of the Territorial

Authority by cooperation to repair or purchase systems.

Board of Road Commissioners or of the Alaska Road Commission; and provided further, that such lines shall be operated and traffic thereon regulated, in such manner as the Board may deem proper; and it is further provided that such rates shall be fixed for telephone communications over such rehabilitated lines as the Board shall deem reasonable and consistent with rates over similar lines in Alaska.

How paid.

Section 3. The Territorial Treasurer is hereby authorized to make payments under this Act upon vouchers submitted by the Alaska Road Commission or by the Territorial Board of Road Commissioners.

Emergency.

Section 4. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval.

CHAPTER 81.

AN ACT

[S. B. 67]

To Authorize the purchase of a cabin for teacher's quarters for the McGrath School, at the town of McGrath, Alaska, making an appropriation therefor, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Appropriation to purchase residence for teacher at McGrath.

Section 1. That the sum of Seven Hundred Dollars (\$700.00) is hereby appropriated, or so much thereof as may be necessary, for the purchase of a cabin to be used as a residence for the teacher of the McGrath School, at the town of McGrath, Alaska, said sum to be expended under the direction of the Commissioner of Education with the approval of the Governor.

Emergency.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
